

Wayland Transfer & Recycling Center 2010 Recycling & Disposal with a “Full Sticker Disposal” Permit

All allowable disposal materials must be deposited in designated trash or bulk waste containers.

All materials for Recycling must be cleanly “separated” and deposited in designated bins

Disposal Permits are for Wayland residents only (proof of residency is required), for Disposal and Recycling of their personal materials originating in the Town of Wayland. No hazardous waste allowed.

Vehicles with Commercial Plates must be weighed and are charged per ton.

**Wayland Landfill FY2010
Limited Recycling with a Recycle Only Permit**

All materials for recycling must be appropriately recycled, cleanly “separated”, and deposited in designated bins.
Recycle Only Permits are for **Wayland residents only** (proof of residency is required), for recycling of their personal materials originating in the Town of Wayland. Residents with Recycle Only Permit Stickers are restricted to the “Recycling Only” area of the Landfill, no exceptions. **No hazardous waste allowed.**

Full Permit Stickers and Single-Trip Disposal Permits are available for residents for disposal of and recycling of other allowable items not included on the list below.

No: American flags, business or commercial items, bulky waste, cell phones, charity for Goodwill or St. Vincent’s, computers, concrete or concrete products or bricks, electronics, eyeglasses, fluorescent light bulbs, hazardous waste, major appliances, medical waste, paint, paint cans, printer cartridges, propane tanks, Styrofoam, swap area/take it or leave it, tires, video tapes, wood or wood furniture, yard waste logs.
