THE 2018 ANNUAL CENSUS FORMS will be mailed to all households in January. Please update, sign and return the census form in the envelope provided or contact the Town Clerk's Office if you do not receive one. Failure to return your census may change your voter status to inactive.

**DOG LICENSE RENEWALS ARE DUE DECEMBER 1, 2017, FOR THE 2018 LICENSING PERIOD.** You can register your dog by mail, in person or online. If you do not receive a notice, no longer have a dog or have a new dog, contact the Town Clerk's Office.


