

## **Circuit Breaker Income Tax Credit**

For Persons Age 65 and Older Low to Moderate-Income Seniors

The Circuit Breaker Income Tax Credit provides tax relief for moderate and low to moderate-income senior citizens. Qualifying senior citizens may claim a credit in their state income tax returns for the real estate taxes paid on their Wayland residential property, in addition **the Town of Wayland matches the Circuit Breaker Income Tax Credit.**

**The town match requires that an applicant must receive the MA State Circuit Breaker Income Tax Credit to be eligible. Applications along with a complete copy of the applicants 2016 MA Income Tax filing are due for the town match by the close of business on April 2nd, 2018.**
