If the court finds that the debt is owed and there is sufficient property and an ability to pay, a warrant to distrain or commit and take the body of such person and commit him to jail shall issue to you or your designee to serve upon said person, according to law. Upon the issuance of the warrant to distrain or commit, you or your designee shall proceed to enforce the collection of said excise in accordance with the provisions of said court warrant.
