42 Shaw Dr.

- S. Glovsky stated his reasoning for wanting to raise the value an incremental amount this year from the value set by the ATB for fiscal '17 based on home improvements and a regular 2.5% value increase. Also, the value won't jump as high next year when the property is back in the system.
- Z. Ventress determined the tax dollars in question are about \$400. It would cost much more than that in staff time and materials to defend the increased value if the Town has to go to the ATB.
- Z. Ventress moved to approve the six abatement applications. S. Rufo seconded. All in favor
- S. Glovsky abstained from voting on 42 Shaw Dr.
- J. Brodie recused himself from voting on 6 Draper Rd.
