
Purpose: At 8:55 pm. C. Karlson called the session to order in the Council on Aging room, Wayland Town Building by unanimous roll call vote of the Board (YEA: M. Antes, L. Anderson, T. Fay, C. Karlson, D. Levine. NAY: none. ABSENT: none. ABSTAIN: none. Adopted 5-0-0.) in open session as permitted by Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 30A, Section 21, (a) (3) to discuss strategy with respect to collective bargaining with the New England Police Benevolent Association (NEPBA)/Wayland Police Officers Union (WPOU) Local 176; Pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 30A, Section 21, (a) (3) to discuss strategy with respect to collective bargaining with Wayland Teachers Association regarding health insurance payroll deductions; and pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 30A, Section 21 (a) (2), (3), and (6), to review and approve the executive session minutes of June 25, 2020 with the intent to hold said minutes.

All members participated remotely via Zoom and confirmed that they were alone and could discuss confidential matters in privacy.

Police: L. Miller reviewed the status of the negotiated Police contract with the Board. In early March, the union and the Town reached agreement in principal on a settlement and the union needed to conduct a ratifying vote. The settlement included a 2% increase for FY21 and language changes that are all net funded within the existing Police budget. The question before the Board now is whether to include the contract in this ATM. T. Fay asked if the negotiations might be reopened to include language L. Miller reminded the Board that in Wayland, the Police Department through its Chief reports to the TA's office. This means that all Human Resource issues are handled in the TA's office, not in the Police Department.

L. Miller suggested including the Police settlement in this ATM and noted that the other Town unions are interested in starting discussions. After discussion, the Board was inclined to move forward at this town meeting.

Minutes: The Board reviewed the draft executive session minutes of June 25, 2020. D. Levine moved, seconded by L. Anderson, to approve and hold the minutes of June 25, 2020.
