On April 17, 2020, the Wayland Board of Selectmen voted to extend the application filing deadline for all Statutory Exemptions, Circuit Breaker Program, and CPA Exemptions to May 1, 2020.

New applications $\underline{\text{must be received}}$ in the Assessors' Office by 12:30 pm on Friday May 1st to be considered.

Delivery of applications can be by USPS mail or by hand delivery to the Town Building. A mail slot marked "Tax Collector" is located just inside the front door of the building. Applications placed there will be taken to the Assessors' Office.
