3. Discuss Next Steps of Grant Funding Cycle

Barbara Holtz mentioned that at least one applicant asked about the status of grant applications. Kara suggested that we could tell them that we voted to fund them. Other members of the Council agreed.

4. WCC Updates

Financial Update: Jon shared that only \$1,771 from last year's grant funds have been paid out.

<u>Grantee Reception</u>: Kara suggested a Grantee Reception in March before a Board of Selectmen meeting. Barbara suggested informing the Town Crier about the reception. Jon recommended contacting the local State Representative and State Senator, the Selectmen, and the President of Arts Wayland. Kara will also reach out to the grantees regarding interest/attendance at the event. Proposed date: March 19 or 26, 2018.

<u>Town Boards</u>: Adam said that there were reservations to use the boards through May 2018. Adam suggested informing the Town Crier about when art is displayed on the boards. Jon mentioned that members of Arts Wayland may not be interested because they cannot sell their art in the Town Building. Adam said that he would contact Arts Wayland
