## 2) River's Edge Update -

- Meeting on Tuesday (11/12) with design review board Changes to exterior plans and colors. New plan has 218 increased units with rear quadrant area allowed to be 4 stories expanded across back of site and little forward toward Route 20. All 3 buildings remain three-story height along Route 20.
- Planning board update
  - o Peer review under way
  - o November 12<sup>th</sup> Variance for additional units, height, size, exposed garages in the back
  - o Plans on Planning Board website
  - o 11/5 (Tuesday) Voted unanimously to recommend to ZBA
  - o Conservation Commission waiting on ZBA approval to provide recommendation
- ZBA meeting at beginning of December is targeted
- Member of the Public asked question on cost of lead remediation on property
- 40B Unit Count Update
  - 60 units planned at Mahoney's site, 12 at School, 218 at River's Edge 10.6% of inventory
  - Housing plan will need to be updated for 2021

## 3) Route 20

- a) Branding/wayfinding grant committee update next meeting December  $5^{th}$  at 11AM at Town Building
- b) Paving, sidewalks & bike path connections Evaluating MassWorks/Complete Streets programs as option
  - Conference call on 11/7 with MassDOT to understand funding options for sidewalks, curbing, lighting
    - o Open question around bike lane and if required for funding support
- c) Water line construction status
  - Bridge connection still pending, should be complete before Winter

- d) Wastewater planning (efforts pending revised permit) review connection costs vs other towns
  - No new update, but in progress
- 4) Memo to BoS re: coordinating across committees –Draft of EDC memo provided to BoS week of 11/4
  - a) Recreation and School land parcels activate for field(s) & trails at little/no cost to Town? Loker Fields to go to next Town Meeting in Spring
  - b) Town Building renovations vs reuse study deed review needed
  - c) Review Conservation Commission & Public Works draft regulations request by Town Administrator Defer to next meeting
- 5) Cochituate
  - a) 70-74 Main Street historic/affordable renovation (across from Hannah Williams playground)
    - Can CPA and Housing Trust funds be used for historic or affordable parts of projects? Housing Trust is conceptually interested, pending resolution of Oxbow/Launcher Way. CPA next step.
    - Oxbow/Launcher Way Under environmental review and Housing Trust is interested in purchasing, so investment will need to be evaluated against that.
      - o EDC to look at how to support planning for this going forward
  - b) 130 Main Street vacant gas station visioning/overlay (by Planning Board) No Update, will not be ready for Town Meeting
- 6) Town Center & Wayland Village (former Whole Foods) plaza
  - a) Town Center leasing
    - Arts Wayland long-term business plan
      - Nancy Boyle Securing grant to drive PR for location. Currently on a monthto-month lease (meet there next EDC meeting)
      - Working with Zurich to get to a longer term lease in order to provide more security in future plan
      - Could it provide a good co-working space
    - xGolf opening week of 11/11
    - Panera is closing in December
  - b) Municipal Pad & Senior/Community Center update RFP for new senior center in town to be released in November
  - c) Fresh Market, Wayland Village leasing update No Update
- 7) "Eat Local" publicize restaurant revenue and its impact to town \$240K/year of food-based revenue based on numbers collected
- 8) Potential state and federal grants and funds for the Town to pursue EDC to research
  - Bill Steinberg contacting different granting authorities to see where opportunities are and making sure that town is aware of all opportunities
