In further efforts to slow the spread of the COVID-19 virus throughout the Commonwealth, **Governor** Baker has prohibited gatherings of over 25 people and on-premises consumption of food or drink. Effective beginning at 12:00 a.m. on Tuesday, March 17, 2020, all on-premises consumption licensees are prohibited from selling alcohol or food to the public until 11:59 p.m. on April 5, 2020, unless further extended or otherwise modified.

This includes restaurants, bars, or all other establishments that offer food or drink.

These establishments may continue to provide food for takeout and delivery only, provided that they follow social distancing protocols (maintaining approximately 6 feet distance from others whenever possible).

Please note that this does not apply to licenses for off-premises consumption, including package stores.

<u>We continue to urge all residents to evaluate their own health</u> and determine if they are feeling mildly ill with a head cold, headache, cough and/or experiencing any CDC identified symptoms of COVID-19.
