Process:

Call ahead of time; no walk ins

- Testing is limited to elderly and those with acute symptoms. Patient must have all 3 symptoms.
- Insured and uninsured are both accepted with highest out of pocket cost of \$200.
- Drive to site and call upon arrival.
- Triaged by clinician while in their car and tested for flu and strep throat first.

- Register on phone and give insurance or payment info
 - Insurance accepted with all copays waived

- Drive to site and call upon arrival
- Triaged by clinician while in their car; directed to outdoor tent for testing, if eligible

- No testing availability; insufficient protective gear for staff.
- Providing tele-visits where a provider speaks with patients through video to determine whether the patient fits the criteria to get tested.
- If the patient is eligible for testing, Charles River provides an order to Metrowest Medical Center.
