- 1) The committee meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M.
In attendance: Richard Turner (RT), Carl Bernardo (CB), George Bernard (GB), Steve Streeter (SS) and Dennis Berry (DB). Not present: John Dyer (JD)
- 2) Public Comment: No Public Comment
- 3) Old Business Minutes from October 11, 2017 were reviewed and approved.
- 4) New Business:
 - Carl is working on obtaining more military vehicles for the 2018 Memorial Day parade. The American Legion will go half on the cost of one military vehicle. The type of vehicle will be determined at a future WPCC meeting.
 - Good news. Richard Turner's brother Tom has stated that the three antique police vehicles in last year's parade will also be in the 2018 Memorial Day parade.
 - RT stated the bronze eagle that is part of the Wayland Veterans Memorial is separating from the base of the Memorial. The epoxy is separating from the granite base. Richard to obtain an estimate of the cost to repair it. This should be a town expense, not a WPCC expense.
 - Richard to start working at the end of January on nominations of residents for the Lydia Child award.
 - Two members of the WPCC have terms that expire in 2018, Steve Streeter and John Dyer. Steve to work on wording for a "draft advertisement" for an individual to join the committee when one of the current members is not seeking another three-year term. Also try to find new members who want to be on the committee for years to come.
 - Possible proper retirement, disposal and burning of American flags at the town dump on Flag Day, June 14, 2018.
