- Public Comment: The Lydia Maria Child award was given to Virginia Steele and several members of the Wayland ESOL group that teach English to immigrants and those in school who need further refinement in the English language. Pictures were taken of awardees.
- Old Business Minutes from March 22, 2018 were reviewed and approved.
- New Business:
 - Steve Streeter has resigned from the committee due to surgery. RT has asked that Steve write a letter of resignation to the Town Clerk's office. His term expires in June, 2018.
 - American Legion Post 133 to pay all costs associated with a half-truck military vehicle in the 2018 Memorial Day parade. The half-track has rubber tracks and will cost \$750.00.
 - The WWII Weapons Carrier will be in the parade with a cost of \$150.00. Three antique Police Cruisers to be in the parade at No Charge.
 - On Memorial Day, GB to set up speakers at Lakeview Cemetery. Town of Wayland to supply generator for speakers. Richard to find individual to watch speakers while George and Carl get parade members in correct marching order for the parade.
 - Richard and George to look at spots to place speakers at Lakeview Cemetery the Saturday before the program.
 - There is a need for a Grand Marshall for the Memorial Day parade. JD to ask Dick Hoyt if he is interested.
 - Richard passed out preliminary event plans documentation for the Memorial Day parade.
 - CSM Pintagro of Natick Labs to inform GB of the speaker that Natick Labs will provide for the Memorial Day program at Lakeview Cemetery by the end of April. MAJ Woodford will be the Chaplain on Memorial Day.
 - New flag at Lokerville WWII Memorial courtesy of Police Chief Swannick.
 - Kevin Delaney to inform GB when Freedom Prize judges can review top essays.
 - Proper retirement, disposal and burning of American flags to take place at the Boy Scouts Club House on Flag Day, June 14, 2018.
 - Committee members to look for a replacement for Steve Streeter.
