

A1. Call to Order, Review Agenda for the Public: At 6:20 p.m. Chair W. Whitney called the meeting of the Select Board to order as a quorum was present. He then reviewed the agenda for members of the public.

A2. Annual Town Meeting 2024 (ATM): Discussion of ATM topics, including but not limited to: review, discuss and possible vote on articles previously deferred to the Annual Town Meeting (ATM), motions, handouts, and address any items related to ATM: W. Whitney suggested that the Board discuss whether it wished to take positions, and, if so, what positions it wished to take, on: 1) an expected motion to refer Article 26, Amend Zoning Bylaws and Town Map - MBTA Communities Multi-Family Housing to the Select Board for further study and report, 2) a substitute motion under Article 27, Amend Zoning Bylaw to Add Retail Self-Storage as a Commercial Use in a New Business B Zone Subdistrict B-1, and 3) Article 27 as printed in the warrant.

With respect of Article 26, T. Fay reminded the Board that it previously had vote to support this article 5-0. He felt that moving forward with the vote at this time (as opposed to having further study) was indicated. A. Bensley said that she felt that the Town Meeting should have the opportunity to vote on the substance of the MBTA Zoning article. C. Martin agreed, as did W. Whitney. T. Fay moved that the Select Board vote to endorse the expected motion to refer Article 26 to the Select Board for further study and a report. The motion was seconded by C. Martin. On a vote of 0-4, the motion to endorse the substitute motion for referral of Article 27 to the Select Board for further study was not approved.

With regard to Article 27, T. Fay indicated that there had been ample opportunity for public discussion on the proposal to add retail self-storage as a permitted use in a Business-B district, including two public hearings and a number of public forums. A. Brenesly concurred, as did C. Martin and W. Whitney. T. Fay then moved that the Select Board vote to endorse a substitute motion to refer Article 27 to the Select Board for further study. The motion was seconded by C. Martin. On a vote of 0-4, the motion did not pass.

The Board then discussed whether it wished to revisit its earlier vote on the main motion of Art. 27 should it be introduced. It was consensus of the board that it wished to do so. C. Martin moved that the board endorse Art. 27 as printed in the warrant should a motion be made to adopt it be made. W. Whitney seconded the motion. On a vote of 1-4, the motion did not pass.

A. Gutbezahl indicated his feeling that the Board need not announce the results of the votes to the Town Meeting, but that we should respond should a question be asked as to whether and how the Board voted on a particular motion.

A3. Topics not reasonably anticipated by the Chair 48 hours in advance, if any: M. McCall requested that the Board meet briefly in Executive Session to discuss an urgent matter with respect to ongoing litigation that had arisen within the past 24 hours. W. Whitney moved that the Select Board enter into Executive Session pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 30A, Section (a) (3) to conduct strategy with respect to the National Opioid Litigation Consortium. The motion was seconded by T. Fay. W. Whitney declared that a public discussion of these matters may have a detrimental effect on the litigating, negotiating or bargaining position of the Town. Roll call vote: YEA: A. Brensley, T. Fay, A. Gutbezahl, C. Martin, W. Whitney. NAY: None. ABSENT: None.

A4. Adjournment: W. Whitney announced that the Board would not reconvene in open session and that no other public business would be conducted at the meeting. At 6:37 p.m., the Board entered into Executive Session, and would adjourn from Executive Session.
