  - d. Housing services contract with RHSO, Town Planner, \$28,000 to cover 2 years (Community Housing (CH), possibly funded with Uncommitted Funds (UC))
  - e. 27 Sherman's Bridge Road site: conservation restriction creation and implementation, installation of ADA-compliant trail, and finish demolition of existing house, \$36,000 (OS)
  - f. Grout-Heard House HVAC replacement, Wayland Historical Society, \$55,000 (HP)
  - g. Preservation of Town records, Town Clerk, \$200,000 (HP)
  - h. Stone's Bridge restoration and preservation, Linda Malenfant, \$400,000 (HP, possibly UC funds)
  - i. Outdoor pool and associated infrastructure rehabilitation, Wayland Community Pool, \$401,000 (Recreation, UC)
  - j. Cochituate park and playground, Eliza J. Norton Foundation, \$1,000,000 (Recreation, UC)
