Application of **Brian and Marta Foley**, the owners for any necessary approvals, findings, special permits and/or variances as may be required in order to construct an unenclosed porch on an existing single family residential dwelling in required yard setbacks on a nonconforming lot (less than 20,000 sf and 120' of frontage) under the Town of Wayland Zoning By-Laws Chapter 198; including but not limited to, Sections 104.2, 201, 203, 401.1.2, 401.1.3 and Article 8, Table of Dimensional Requirements.
