#### **QUESTIONS AND CLARIFICATIONS**

#### 1. Clarification:

The awarded contractor for IFB #20-1012, WAYLAND HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC FIELD BUILDINGS contract shall be responsible to provide coordination and cooperation with the awarded site contractor for IFB #19-1057 IMPROVEMENTS TO WAYLAND HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC FACILITIES. The demarcation of work at the three building installation locations: storage building, restroom building, and ticket/concession building shall be as follows:

**Building Contractor (Contract IFB #20-1012)** – Installation of all work above and including the floor slab, connections to all utility feeds installed by the site contractor through the foundation and stubbed up to subgrade elavation.

**Site Contractor (Contract IFB #19-1057)** – Installation of all work to include excavation, foundation installation, backfill, utility installations, and feeds through the foundation, and stubbed to subgrade elevation and all finished pavement materials to the face of the building.

**2. Question:** Specification Section 07 41 13, and detail 4/A103, calls for gutters and downspouts; however, none are shown on the roof plan or on the elevations. Are gutters and downspouts required and, if so, please indicate locations.

**Response:** There are no downspouts or gutters on the project. Contractor shall delete all references to gutter shown on detail 4 / A103. Delete reference to integral gutters, downspouts, rain leaders throughout specification Section 07 41 13, STANDING SEAM METAL ROOF. Deleted specification 07 41 13, STANDING SEAM METAL ROOF, Section 2.05 FABRICATION – GUTTERS AND DOWNSPOUTS and Section 3.06 INSTALLATION – GUTTERS, AND 3.07 INSTALLATION – DOWNSPOUTS in their entirety.

**3. Question:** Which trade is responsible for furnishing and installing the soffit vent shown on Detail/Drawing 4/A103?

**Response:** The General Contractor is responsible for installing the soffit vent shown in detail 4 / A103

**4. Question:** Which trade is responsible for furnishing and installing the metal sill flashing shown on Detail/Drawing 3/A103, the head flashing shown on Details/Drawing 3 & 5/A301 and at the flashed horizontal joint shown on Details/Drawing 1 & 4/A302?

**Response:** The General Contractor is responsible for furnishing and installing the metal sill flashing at 3 / A103, the fiber cement to pre-cast sill transition, 3&5 / A301, the door head flashing, and at 4 / A302, the flashed horizontal joint.

**5. Question:** Detail/Drawing 2/A302 calls for self-adhering rolled asphalt cap & base sheet (2-layers). The base sheet does not appear to be listed within Specification Section 07 31 13. Please provide product specification.




