NOTIFICATION OF AQUATIC TREATMENT SUDBURY RIVER – WAYLAND/SURBURY

The stretch of the Sudbury River between Sherman's Bridge Road and Route 27 will be chemically treated with a USEPA/MA registered aquatic herbicide, Clearcast (Imazamox) targeting the control of invasive water chestnut, on Wednesday, July 13, 2022. The management area of the river will be closed to swimming, boating, and fishing until Thursday, July 14, 2022. In the event of rain, the stretch of river will be treated on Thursday, July 14, 2022, and will be closed to swimming, boating, and fishing until Friday, July 15, 2022. Temporary signs that warn of the applicable water use restrictions, will be posted at access points in advance of treatment. The work is being performed for US Fish and Wildlife Service, under contract to Water & Wetland, LLC and pursuant to Orders of Conditions permits from the Sudbury and Wayland Conservation Commissions and License to Apply Chemicals permit from MA DEP.
