Register using a form: If you are not able to register online you may register by completing a form. Forms will be available at the Health Department, Transfer Station, Council on Aging, Library.

As always, we encourage residents/homeowners to minimize the generation of household hazardous waste and to buy only the quantities of paint, solvents, cleaners, pool supplies, pesticides and other hazardous materials that are needed, to utilize non-hazardous materials (if possible) instead of hazardous materials, to share leftover supplies with neighbors or others who might need to use them, and to donate paint and other useful materials to organizations that might be able to use them.

DO BRING THE FOLLOWING TYPES OF HOUSEHOLD PRODUCTS FOR DISPOSAL:

PAINT THINNER, SOLVENTS
OIL-BASED PAINTS
STRIPPERS
PHOTO CHEMICALS
DRAIN AND OTHER CLEANERS
ACIDS
ROOF CEMENT
DRIVEWAY SEALER
SPOT REMOVERS
GLUES & RESINS
BRAKE FLUID
POOL CHEMICALS
WEED KILLERS
INSECTICIDES, POISONS
PESTICIDES, HERBICIDES
KEROSENE, GASOLINE

DO NOT BRING THE FOLLOWING TYPES OF PRODUCTS TO THE COLLECTION:

AMMUNITION, FIREARMS, EXPLOSIVES
CONSTRUCTION WASTE OR BUILDING MATERIALS
GAS CYLINDERS, PRESSURIZED CONTAINERS
(OTHER THAN AEROSOL CANS)
PRESSURE-SENSITIVE AND HIGHLY REACTIVE MATERIALS
INFECTIOUS MEDICAL OR BIOLOGICAL WASTE
PHARMACEUTICAL WASTE, DRUGS
RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS
DIOXIN-FORMING MATERIALS INCLUDING 2, 4, 5-T
ASBESTOS

BUSINESS OR COMMERCIAL HAZARDOUS WASTE
CRTs, CTUs, COMPUTERS, MONITORS, TVs, etc.

**ITEMS THAT MAY BE BROUGHT TO LANDFILL
RECYCLING AREA: (TRANSFER STATION PERMIT
REQUIRED) MOTOR OIL, BATTERIES, ANTIFREEZE,
LATEX PAINT/WATER BASED PAINT**

**LATEX PAINT (MAY BE AIR-DRIED or KITTY LITTER
ADDED, BAGGED AND DISPOSED OF WITH REGULAR
TRASH**

MERCURY PRODUCTS WILL BE COLLECTED

Safe Transport tips: Please keep household hazardous materials in their original containers, tighten caps and lids, sort and pack separately; oil paint, pesticides, household cleaners; securely in boxes or other containers when transporting to the collection. Containers should be in sturdy upright boxes padded with newspaper. Do **not** mix into any single container any substances which may result in a hazardous reaction or an explosive or shock sensitive material. To help expedite the collection process, separate waste materials by type. Pack your car and drive immediately to the site.

PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE YOUR VEHICLE WHEN YOU ARRIVE AT THE COLLECTION SITE; YOUR MATERIALS WILL BE UNLOADED FOR YOU. UNLOCK YOUR TRUNK, IF POSSIBLE, PRIOR TO ARRIVING AT THE SITE. SMOKING IS PROHIBITED AT THE SITE.
