Hi Jim!

Please see the following:

Rain Garden Plantings!

Ten 1 gallon of tussock sedge, ten 1 gallon switch grass, ten 1 gallon blue flag iris, ten 1 gallon new england aster, ten 1 gallon iris versicolor, and ten 1 gallon spartive pectivata.

All of these 60 one gallon plants were spaced out evenly throughout a 1500 square foot area 20 foot radius. They were all planted with composted loam peat moss and healthy startfertilizer.

As per the outside area of the rain garden the hydro seed was 5 pounds of the New England Erosion Control Restoration Mix for Moist Sites combo of native grasses and wildflowers.

SPECIES: Riverbank Wild Rye (*Elymus riparius*), Creeping Red Fescue (*Festuca rubra*), Little Bluestem (*Schizachyrium scoparium*), Big Bluestem (*Andropogon gerardii*), Switch Grass (*Panicum virgatum*), Upland Bentgrass (*Agrostis perennans*), Nodding Bur Marigold (*Bidens cernua*), Hollow-Stem Joe Pye Weed (*Eupatorium fistulosum*/Eutrochium fistulosum), New England Aster (*Aster novae-angliae*), Boneset (*Eupatorium perfoliatum*), Blue Vervain (*Verbena hastata*), Soft Rush (*Juncus effusus*), Wool Grass (*Scirpus cyperinus*).
