About this Property

Cow Common is a 72.1 acre property with open grass fields and red maple swamp. The Wayland Community Gardens are located within Cow Common.

The main trail is a 2.1 mi easy loop, with a few short out-and-back detours into the woods.

Cow Common closes from April-September to protect breeding populations of Bobolink, a statethreatened grassland bird.



The Conservation Department holds bird walks at this location each spring to observe the American Woodcock and species of shorebirds, such as Killdeer
