The new bodies will be reused in future vehicle replacements, reducing funding needed to complete new vehicles. Description & Justification: W2 is a scheduled replacement of one of the water fleet vehicles which is part of the 30 year DPW vehicle/equipment capital plan. Current vehicle has 95k miles and the utility body has significant rust/ rot. The new vehicle will be part of the service/water fleet and will be part of snow plowing operations.
