Dog walking rules:

This is the only Conservation area in Wayland with a boat launch area for kayaking, canoeing, and recreational fishing on the Sudbury River. Access to the boat launch is about 0.4 mi from the parking lot.

*Please do not dig for bait within the Conservation Area.

The trail network at Greenways totals just over 3 mi.

The trail around the north field is about 1.5 mi long. This area is fairly flat.

The trail around the south field is also about 1.5 mi long, with some hills. The trails are easy-to-moderate.

A portion of the north field is managed by the Recreation Department.
