HMLP Mission

Our mission is to enable people to continue to live in their own home and be as independent as possible.

Home Modification Loan Program



Helping you live more independently at home



The Home Modification Loan Program (HMLP) is a state-funded lending program that provides **0% or 3% interest** loans to fund necessary changes/modifications to keep disabled or elderly family members in their homes and communities.

HMLP provides loans up to:

- \$50,000 for land and dwelling properties
- \$30,000 for mobile homes

HMLP Eligibility Requirements

- ✓ Household gross income must be at or below 200% of HUD-published area median income
- √ 0% interest loans available to homeowners
- √ 3% interest loans available to landlords of buildings under 10 units, with qualifying tenant(s)

HMLP Application Process

Applications are reviewed by SMOC on a first come first serve basis to determine both income eligibility and eligibility of the proposed modification.

- Items required as part of your application:
 - certification that the proposed modification relates to the beneficiary's ability to function on a day to day basis
 - verification of household size and gross income
 - a professional's certification of proposed modifications
 - verification of paid state income taxes and property taxes
 - copy of the property deed or the manufactured/mobile home bill of sale
 - applicants must have less than \$75,000 in liquid type assets

HMLP Contractors

- Homeowners hire the contractor/or vendor of their choice to modify the home
- Contractors must be licensed and insured

Contractor bids for the Home Modification Loan

Program must be detailed

 A homeowner's chosen contractor will need to complete HMLP's required Bid Form & Invoice Form












