MOTION – 2018 SPECIAL TOWN MEETING

ARTICLE 1: PAY PREVIOUS FISCAL YEARS UNPAID BILLS

I MOVE YOU SIR:

MOVED: that the Town approve the payment of bills of prior fiscal years as listed on page 5 of the Warrant for the November 13, 2018 Special Town Meeting from the Fiscal Year 2019 appropriation for the Facilities Budget to be used to pay the bills so listed as items number 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 and from the Fiscal Year 2019 appropriation for the School Budget to be used to pay the bills so listed as items number 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10.

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ARTICLE 2: CURRENT YEAR TRANSFERS

I MOVE YOU SIR:

MOVED: that the sum be appropriated as listed on page 6 of the Warrant for the November 13, 2018 Special Town Meeting and as amended by this motion to be expended by the following officer, board and committee in Fiscal Year 2019 for the following purpose:

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ARTICLE 3: FUND FISCAL YEARS 2018 AND 2019 TOWN SUCCESSOR COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT

I MOVE YOU SIR:

MOVED: that the Town transfer \$135,000 from the FY19 Budgeted Reserve for Salary Settlement account and \$25,100 from the FY19 Information Technology Personnel Services line item for the purpose of funding FY19 and retroactively funding FY18 of the incremental cost increases of the collective bargaining agreement for the period of July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2019 between the Town of Wayland and the New England Police Benevolent Association, Inc., Local 176, as follows, and that the Finance Director be authorized to distribute such amounts, as appropriate, to and among the department personnel and line items affected thereby.

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ARTICLE 4: ZONING: UPDATE FLOOD PLAIN MAPS

I MOVE YOU SIR:

MOVED: that the Town amend Chapter 198 of the code of the Town of Wayland, the Town's Zoning Bylaw by adopting the revision to Section 198-302.1.2, the Federal Flood Protection District, as printed in Article 4 on Page 8 of the Warrant for the November 13, 2018 Special Town Meeting.

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ARTICLE 5: FUND ASBESTOS MITIGATION AT RIVER’S EDGE

I MOVE YOU SIR:

MOVED: that the Town appropriate the sum of \$790,530 to be expended under the direction of the Board of Selectmen for the removal and related costs of removal of asbestos containing materials and associated soil on Town-owned land on Boston Post Road in Wayland, MA as shown on Assessor’s map 22, lots 3, 6 and 7, also known as the River’s Edge Site, such costs to include but not be limited to costs for contractor, administrative, legal, consulting, environmental and engineering services and compliance fees, and to meet this appropriation, the Town Treasurer, with approval of the Board of Selectmen is authorized to borrow said sum pursuant to the provisions of G.L. c. 44, §§7 or 8, or any other enabling authority, and to issue bonds or notes of the Town therefor; and further, that any premium received by the Town upon the sale of any bonds or notes approved by this vote, less any such premium applied to the payment of the costs of issuance of such bonds or notes, to be applied to the payment of costs approved hereunder in accordance with G.L. c.44, §20, thereby reducing by a like amount the amount authorized to be borrowed to pay such costs.

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ARTICLE 6: ZONING: ESTABLISH DISTRICT FOR MARIJUANA ESTABLISHMENTS AND MEDICAL MARIJUANA TREATMENT CENTERS

I MOVE YOU SIR:

MOVED: that the Town (1) amend the Town’s Zoning Map to create a new Marijuana Establishments overlay zoning district comprising of Wayland parcels Map 22-010, 21-005, 21-008A, 21-002, 21-004, 21-002A, 21-001, 21-008, 21-006A, 21-006 and 21-003; (2) amend Chapter 198 of the Code of Wayland, the Town’s Zoning Bylaw, by adding Article 26 “Marijuana Establishments District”; and (3) amend Chapter 198, Attachment 3 of the Code of Wayland, the Table of Permitted Principal Uses by District to include the Marijuana Establishments District as printed in Article 6 on Pages 12-20 of the Warrant for the November 13, 2018 Special Town Meeting.

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ARTICLE 7: ZONING: PROHIBIT RECREATIONAL MARIJUANA ESTABLISHMENTS

I MOVE YOU SIR:

MOVED: that the Town amend Chapter 198 of the code of the Town of Wayland, the Town's Zoning Bylaw by adopting the revision to Section 198-803, Classification of Principal Uses, Section 803.5, Prohibited Uses, as printed in Article 7 on Page 24 of the Warrant for the November 13, 2018 Special Town Meeting.

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**ARTICLE 8: ZONING: USE OF PRE-EXISTING NONCONFORMING
LAND THAT CONSISTS OF MORE THAN SIX
DWELLING UNITS**

I MOVE YOU SIR:

MOVED: that the Town amend Chapter 198 of the code of the Town of Wayland, the Town's Zoning Bylaw by inserting a new Section 401.1.2.1 as printed in Article 8 on Page 27 of the Warrant for the November 13, 2018 Special Town Meeting.

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ARTICLE 9: LOKER GRASS FIELD

I MOVE YOU SIR:

MOVED: that the Town:

- 1) appropriate the sum of \$1,500,000 to be expended under the direction of the Wayland Recreation Commission for the permitting, design, engineering, and construction of a multi-purpose grass athletic playing field (soccer U12 size 165' x 240') at the Loker Conservation & Recreation Area including playing surfaces, drainage, landscaping, traffic (including a Rt. 30 traffic congestion mitigation plan to deal with the Loker field traffic), access (must meet all state and local emergency vehicle access requirements) and parking and any and all other costs incidental or related thereto;
- 2) authorize the Treasurer with the approval of the Board of Selectmen, to borrow \$1,500,000 pursuant to G. L. c. 44, §§7 or 8 or any other enabling authority, and issue bonds or notes of the Town therefor; and
- 3) authorize any premium received by the Town upon the sale of any bonds or notes approved by this vote, less any such premium applied to the payment of the costs of issuance of such bonds or notes, to be applied to the payment of cost approved hereunder in accordance with G. L c.44, §20, thereby reducing by a like amount the amount authorized to be borrowed to pay such costs.

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ARTICLE 10: LIMIT DISCHARGE OF WEAPONS

I MOVE YOU SIR:

MOVED: that the Town amend §139-8 of Chapter 139 of the code of the Town of Wayland by deleting said section and replacing with the following new section 139-8:

A. No person shall carry uncased or unholstered firearms, rifles, shotguns, or pistols or discharge explosives on public property without the prior written permission of the Board of Selectmen or on private property without the written permission of its owner.

B. No person shall fire or discharge any type of firearm, rifle, shotgun, or pistol on land within the confines of the Town unless they are at least 1000 feet from the nearest dwelling and 1000 feet within the property line of said land.

C. This section does not apply to the lawful defense of life or property or to any person in the performance of some legal duty or to the otherwise lawful discharge of blank ammunition.
