WAYLAND TOWN BEACH is our hidden gem that offers sun and fresh water swimming on the North Pond of Lake Cochituate.

During the season, our 60,000 square foot swim area is patrolled by lifeguards and the water quality is tested weekly by the Health Department.

Visitors can enjoy over 300 feet of waterfront and accessible docks for family fun.

Town Beach features shaded picnic areas with charcoal grills, sport courts & a pre-k playground and complimentary lounge chairs.

LAKE COCHITUATE - WATER QUALITY

Each week, the Health Department tests the water for E.coli bacteria and DCR tests for PFAS and cyanobacteria. We also remove nuisance weeds and rake the shoreline each day. Typically our beach and swim area test low for bacteria - well below the state safety threshold.

Rest assured, if the lab results would ever reach the threshold, which can happen after heavy rains, we have strict and swift protocols in place to close the beach until the levels return to normal. Water is tested during marked beach season dates only. Lab results are posted online each week of the season.
